PARTY BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By placing this order for a party at Wirral Slotcar Racing, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- A deposit is required at time of booking.
- Deposits are non-refundable however we will happily change the date or time of your party if needed (subject to availability and with at least 7 days notice.)
- The balance must be paid 7 days prior to date of party.
- **IF APPLICABLE** Once final numbers have been confirmed 7 days prior to the party food will be ordered in and prepared on the day of the party. We are unable to offer refund for children that do not turn up for the party. However as a gesture of goodwill we will offer a complimentary admission ticket for each child that does not show to race at one of our open day functions.
- The company reserves the right to cancel any booking due to non-payment of balance by the due date.
- Children must be supervised by parent/guardians whilst visiting Wirral Slotcar Racing.
- Only children aged 7 and over are suitable to have a Slotcar Party unless supervised by parent/guardians.
- WSR VENUE BOOKINGS ONLY Due to our party schedule, party guests will not be admitted
 into the building until the allocated party time and must vacate promptly when their
 allocated time ends. Party guests must also arrive and leave the party area within the time
 they are allocated to the party area; this is to allow us to service the area for the next guests.
- **IF APPLICABLE** Any additional siblings or friends accompanying party guests will be charged our standard entrance rate.

- WSR VENUE BOOKINGS ONLY Children and parents/careers are not allowed to enter the kitchen unless authorized.
- Our standard rules of Slotcar Racing must be followed by all visitors.

RACE CONTROL RULES

- We are pleased to provide this wonderful facility and whilst we have attempted to make it as safe as possible, the very nature of children's play activity means that accidents can occasionally happen. Parental Supervision is essential at all times.
- WSR VENUE BOOKINGS ONLY Seating for adults will be provided in the main racing hall.
- Children should use the toilet and wash their hands before entering the race area.
- Age restrictions are enforced for slotcar racing unless supervised by parent/guardians.
- Admission is limited to 2 hours.
- Please do enter race control area.
- No food, drink or chewing gum should be taken into the slotcar racing area.
- IF APPLICABLE Only food and drink purchased from WSR may be consumed in the premises.
- It is forbidden to smoke within the building.
- Children must walk at all times.
- Children who are unwell should not enter the slotcar racing area.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behaviour and well being of the child in their care and must maintain supervision at all times.
- In the interest of Health and Safety, please ensure that any food debris which falls on the floor is picked/wiped up as soon as possible. Report any spillage to a member of staff.
- Report all accidents to a member of staff, to ensure that we can provide any necessary assistance and minimize the potential of re-occurrence. These will be logged and are an important part of ongoing safety audits.
- All damages to Wirral Slotcar Racing property either accidental or deliberate must be reported to a member of staff, (With exceptions to Slotcars coming out of the slots while racing).



- Nappy changing and the use of potties etc. should be conducted in a suitable area.
- Whilst hosting Children's activity, no aggressive or intimidating behaviour or use of inappropriate language will be tolerated. Guilty parties will be asked to leave.
- Any guest found breaching these rules may be asked to leave.

Wirral Slotcar Racing encourages Slotcar Racing as an activity for all children as an exciting fun experience in a safe environment. As such, there are inherent risks that are always associated with children playing and having fun together. These include children being exposed to moderate tripping, falling and bumping into each other. We have taken every reasonable step to control these risks through design, maintenance and operation of the facility. However, it is impossible to eliminate such risks completing whilst providing a stimulation environment and parents/guardians must recognize and except these risk.
